Program Options

You will visit **3 different program areas** during the event. Choose your **top 5** programs when registering. We will do our best to accommodate your top 3 preferences.

Accounting & Business Administration: Learn the basics of running a business, managing money, and keeping financial records. Study business operations, finance, and bookkeeping for immediate employment or continued business study.

Biology: Discover how living things work through hands-on labs in a science-focused program covering foundational biological principles and skills for students pursuing health sciences or transfer degrees.

Business Management: Build practical skills in leadership, teamwork, and running day-to-day operations to prepare for a wide range of business careers. Step into the world of business and see if you have what it takes to lead! This session will include a hands-on business simulation designed to introduce you to the Business Management program and the skills you'll develop to be successful in a business career.

Cosmetology: Learn the hands-on skills that train students in hair, skin, and nail services to prepare for state licensure and work in the beauty industry.

Criminal Justice/Sociology: Explore how your passion for people, justice, and community can turn into a meaningful career by learning about our Criminal Justice and Sociology programs. Whether you're ready to protect and serve or want to better understand how society works and make a difference, this session will help you discover the path that fits your goals.

Early Childhood Education: Prepare to work with young children by studying development and learning how kids grow, learn, and thrive in childcare and preschool settings.

History: Explore past events, cultures, and ideas to better understand how the world developed and why it works the way it does today.

Nursing: Discover how a nursing education builds strong clinical skills, real patient-care experience, and the confidence to step into a rewarding healthcare career.

Psychology: Explore why people think, feel, and act the way they do. This introductory program focuses on human behavior, mental processes, and research methods.

Radiography: Train to use medical imaging equipment (X-Ray) to help support and diagnose patients and prepares them for radiologic technologist certification.

Transfer Pathways/Liberal Arts: Pathways offer a clear, affordable route for students to start their education at Southeast and seamlessly continue to a four-year university. With guided advising and guaranteed credit transfer within the Minnesota State system, students can confidently build toward their bachelor's degree from day one.
